Effective Jan 1, 2021, UCR Summary Reporting is being discontinued and will be replaced with NIBRS.

Will your agency be ready?

The Clovis Police Department is hosting a **free** National Incident-Based Reporting System training which will be conducted by Brad Zoladz of the FBI.

What is NIBRS?

NIBRS is a more comprehensive crime data collection system which capture specific details about crimes and offenders through incident-based reporting. NIBRS captures details on each single crime incident—*as well as on separate offenses within the same incident*—including location, time of day, whether the incident was cleared, as well as information on victims, known offenders, relationships between victims and offenders, arrestees, and property involved in the crimes. NIBRS expands UCR crime data from summary counts of eight crime categories to specific incident-level data for 49 different crimes. In total, there are 58 data elements that are potentially reported for a NIBRS incident. This is drastically different from how we are currently reporting and will require significant changes in how information is gleaned from police reports. Each agency will want to ensure that their RMS system is NIBRS ready and that their officers are aware that the potential exists that more information will need to be included in police reports.

Unlike data reported through UCR's traditional Summary System -an aggregate monthly tally of crimes- the NIBRS data goes much deeper because of its ability to provide circumstances and context for crimes. Ultimately, NIBRS will improve the detail and overall quality of crime data, which will help law enforcement and communities around the country use resources more strategically and effectively.

Brad will help you learn about the transition to NIBRS and how it will improve the accuracy and timeliness of crime statistics, help identify crime patterns and trends and aid in crime prevention. There will be limited training opportunities in California so now is the time to take advantage of this offering.
